

SERMON DISCUSSION STARTERS

- 1 **How has God revealed His “glorious deeds, his might, or the wonders that he has done.”** (Ps 78:4) recently? Who can you share these things with that could encourage them to set their hope in God? Does reflecting on God’s action in your life inspire faithfulness? Praise God for His faithfulness!
- 2 **Israel was being called upon to remember and pass on God’s great work of deliverance on their behalf.** What is God’s supreme work of deliverance that we are to pass on today? (See 1 Corinthians 15:3-4) What does Paul say is the most important part of God’s Story? What elements are part of the story?
- 3 **Read Psalm 78:7-8.** God desires that we place our hope in Him. How do we practically place our hope in God? What is the result of not placing your hope in God?
- 4 **Read Deuteronomy 6:4-12.** What does God emphasize in this passage? How can we orient our lives, activities, and conversations around remembering God’s story and telling it to others? **Read Deuteronomy 6:20-25.** What is the result of hearing and telling God’s story?
- 5 **We have been redeemed into community.** Are you actively seeking to teach God’s story to the next generation? Who are people from the next generation in your life whom you can invest in? How can you share God’s Story with them? How are you equipping the next generation and those around you to tell God’s Story?
- 6 **Read Psalm 78:9-72, where do we see that God as the following?** A generous king? _____
A victorious warrior? _____ A righteous judge? _____ A glorious God? _____
An atoning sacrifice? _____ A good shepherd? _____ A loving father? _____
